



Explanation of Professional Services

Dear Eye Gotcha Patient:

The routine, comprehensive eye exam includes a refraction to determine any spectacle lens correct and a dilated comprehensive eye health exam. Contact lens evaluations/fittings and other professional services such as an office visit for non-routine concerns are not included with the routine exam and **may not be covered by your insurance**. Below are some guidelines for the prices some of the non-routine services run out of pocket.

Service	Cost
Comprehensive Eye Exam Including refraction, dilation, and routine eye health check without follow-up visits	\$140
Contact Lens Services Including evaluation of existing lenses with service cost depending on the complexity	\$50 - \$250
Office Visit Non-routine medical evaluations including emergency visits with service cost depending on complexity	\$50-\$250
Follow-up Visit Additional visits for existing conditions which were evaluated in office within the past 90 days	\$35-\$250
